We also have a new district resource officer (Officer Borders) to assist in creating a wise-choice making atmosphere.

Bullying is: Deliberate and hurtful behavior that is repeated over a period of time toward the same person. Typically, there is an imbalance of power between the bully and victim.

Student Tips: Stop and think. Treat others the way you want to be treated. Ask the person to stop, ignore the bully, stay with other people, don't be alone, tell an adult. Bullies get their power from our negative emotions. Try to act calm and move away to safe peers. We can't help unless we are made aware of the situation. A student must inform a teacher, the principal, or an adult you trust. Everyone has a right to feel safe at school.
