Blackboard Connect-All Call-You can receive a phone call that school is cancelled through our parent notification system. Please contact the unit office if you would like added to the parent notification system.

e-mail Database-If you are on my e-mail database list, I will e-mail an announcement of the cancellation or schedule change.
