Test/Quiz – 50% You will be assessed at the end of each unit, and with quizzes during the unit.

Homework – 40% There will be various homework assignments each unit. We will also be doing various projects from time to time. Everything you do in class will have a point value.

Participation – 10% You will turn notes in each unit for participation points. Also a daily current events log will be kept for points each quarter

Classroom Rules

- ***Be prepared each day.*** Bring textbook, pencil, paper, agenda book and current events log everyday to class. When the bell rings find your seat and get ready to begin class. Excessive abuse of this will result in a tardy for the day.

- ***History class is for History work.*** You will not do class work from another class in here unless given permission to do so.
- ***Handbook Rules.*** All handbook rules apply to history class. I will follow handbook rules in regards to tardiness, cell phones, hats, etc. (DO NOT bring your hat to my class)
- ***NO Food or Big Swiggs!*** You may bring in drinks as long as they are from the commons in a bottle. No drinks with lids etc. You will not be allowed to bring food into the classroom, unless it is sold for fundraiser in the hallway.
