

Math Facts

Since we will be starting multiplication in October, and many students are still struggling with their addition and subtraction facts, I have decided to send home a math fact practice sheet that will require a parent signature. I do not assign homework, but this will be the student's homework each week. I will send a sheet asking for either 30 minutes of addition, subtraction, or multiplication practice during the week. Sheets will be sent home on Monday, and they will be due on Friday with a parent signature verifying that your student practiced facts with you. The students will receive a grade at the end of the guarter based on how many signed sheets that they return. Students can practice facts by playing a game on abcya.com or other app for addition/subtraction. Students can practice by using flash cards. Flash cards are available at both Walmart and Dollar General for \$1, or a parent can make up practice pages. I don't care how students practice, as long as they are practicing! 🙂
