# SOURCE CARDS TO NOTE CARDS

## Note Cards – Step Two

## WRITE THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION ON THE NOTE CARD

- Top Line
  - Subtopic (left)
  - Source card letter (right)
  - Note card number (behind source card letter)
  - Begin renumbering with every new source

## Note Cards – Step One

#### **ONLY WORK WITH ONE SOURCE AT A TIME!!**

- Choose a source
- Locate the first paragraph in the source you want to use in your paper
- Identify the subtopic for that paragraph
  - If more than one subtopic exists in a single paragraph, you will need to separate the subtopics.

## Note Cards – Step Three

#### **Internet and Data Bases**

- Cut paragraphs from research
- Glue 1 paragraph / subtopic per note card
- Must cut paragraphs in half if they contain multiple subtopics
- Write page numbers at bottom (if not available write no page)

## Note Cards – Step Three

#### **Books**

- Copy information word-for-word onto card
- Information may be photocopied or typed and then cut and glued
- Write page numbers at the bottom

### **Note Cards**

- Remember to work with one source at a time
- Paragraphs divided between two pages may be placed on the same card
  - Draw arrows to label page numbers

- 5 source Cards
  - Lettered
  - Source note
  - Tabs
- 80 note cards
  - Labeled
    - Subtopic
    - Source letter
    - Note Card #
    - Page # (or no page)
