## Mrs. Stevens Classroom Setup 6<sup>th</sup> Grade Government & Health

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GRADING PROCEDURES: The grading scale is posted in the room. Your grade will be based on homework/class work, tests, projects, etc. The preparation for tests will come from paying attention in class, completing homework & projects, & studying for tests. I believe all students have it within themselves to learn the curriculum & earn an excellent grade in this class.

## CLASSROOM RULES & EXPECTATIONS

- 1. Students will maintain respect for everyone and their property. This means no horseplay, no rude or foul language, no bullying. Treat people how you would like to be treated. Do not write on the desks!
- 2. **Be prepared for class**. Bring your chrome book, homework, ear buds, sharpened pencils, paper, silent reading book, etc.
- 3. Everyone will work during class time. Students will not be allowed to work on other subjects, unless they have already completed the day's instructions and have permission. Also students will work until the bell each day. We will not be going to the door and waiting for the bell.
- 4. Students will remain in the classroom until permission is given to leave the room. Students will be dismissed by the teacher, not by the bell. A student will not be allowed to leave the classroom without permission.
- 5. Students will do their own work. Any student found cheating on a test or assignment will receive a zero unless eligible for a 24 hour extension to redo "an assignment" for a maximum grade of 70%D.
- 6. Be in your seat & ready to work when the bell rings. Class activities begin immediately & end only when the teacher dismisses class.
- 7. One person speaks at a time & no one will interfere with others' right to learn. Raise your hand before speaking!! When the teacher is talking, YOU'RE NOT! When you're speaking, we're not!
- 8. **BATHROOM PASSES:** Please use these wisely and only when truly needed.
- 9. LATE WORK POLICY: It is vital that school work be completed on the time and day that it is due. Students will receive plenty of class time to complete assignments. If you receive an opportunity to take an assignment with you, you will be required to turn it in at the beginning of class the following class day. If not, it will be counted as late. Late work will also result in a 20% deduction from original grade. Students who have excused absences will be given two days for each day missed to make up their work.

Unexcused absences will have one day for each day missed to make up their work. Any work not completed & turned in after a week will result in a zero.

- 10. I expect you to behave while under the supervision of a substitute teacher.
- 11. No gum chewing allowed!
- 12. No water bottle flip tricks allowed! Only water is allowed in class no other drink choices!

## Technology Rules

- 1. If you are asked to move for any reason, please carry the chrome book with two hands and hold the chrome book by the base not the cover.
- 2. No banging, slamming, or hitting the chrome book. Be gentle with the keys. Use with clean and dry hands. Do not delete apps or extensions. Do not install or download anything without permission.
- 3. Stay focused on the activity! Remain on task at all times. Do not visit pages that are not directly related to your assignment. Only use approved sites. Tell your teacher right away if you see something inappropriate online.
- 4. Do not touch someone else's chrome book.
- 5. No food or drink allowed near devices.
- 6. Tune in when the teacher is talking! Stop when directed and shut down before closing the chrome book.
- 7. Place your chrome book on a sturdy level surface to avoid falls. Dropping a chrome book can damage it. If you find damage on your device tell your teacher right away.
- 8. Do not share your usernames or passwords! Never give out your personal information online.
- 9. Pay attention to your device's battery life. Try to remember to make sure it is fully charged the night before.
- 10. Practice good digital citizenship.
- 11. Use safe and respectful volume levels. Make sure it is either muted or bring your own ear buds.

## <u>Consequences:</u>

<u>Simplified Classroom Disruption Policy:</u> This policy assists in creating a positive environment in which all students can learn. For reoccurring classroom disruptions, such as: continuous talking, frequently out of seat, chewing on gum-candy-or any objects (choking hazards and a distraction), late assignments, leaving books and belongings, not prepared for class, and refusing to work will warrant a detention.  $1^{st}$  = warning,  $2^{nd}$  = DETENTION.
