Student Motivation Strategies:

To positively promote homework completion, academic achievement, attendance, respectful behavior, and wise-choice making.

- **Scholastic Tickets** (Midterm and Quarter, every 4 weeks)
 - Students with 1 or less late assignments will receive a scholastic ticket
 - Students with agenda books completed will receive a scholastic ticket
 - Teachers can randomly distribute tickets for academic achievement or good behavior
 - At each quarter, scholastic tickets will be distributed for students who have missed no more than 2 days for that quarter

- **Accountability Drawing** (Midterm and Quarter, every 4 weeks)
 - All scholastic tickets will be entered into the “accountability drawing” during lunch periods for prizes
 - Last year we gave away over 1500 prizes (most donated)

- **Achievement Movie** (At the conclusion of each quarter)
 - Students must achieve **at least 2** of the 3 requirements to earn a movie ticket to submit to attend a movie shown in the commons on a big screen with popcorn and a beverage
 1. Cumulative weekly grade of an A, B, or C for 75% of the quarter (allowed to be on D/F list twice each quarter)
 2. Verbal warnings for discipline but no “write-ups” for the quarter
 3. 95% attendance rate for the school year as required by IL Law
****as part of student accountability with organization and responsibility, the student must have their ticket with them to be able to enter for the movie—we do NOT allow students to call for their ticket***
