Winter Weather

The new year brings an increased chance of winter weather. As in the past, we will make decisions on school closings as quick as possible and communicate the closing through our all call system, the district website, the district Facebook page, and WNOI.

This is the first year our district has an approved e-learning plan that can be utilized in the event of school closings. Our initial thought was that e-learning days could be used in the same manner as emergency days in the past. We believed these days would count for instruction and take the place of needing to use emergency days once we have reached five e-learning days. However, we have since been informed that while e-learning days do count as instructional days and do not have to be made up, once you reach five e-learning days you still have to use all five emergency days before you can use Act of God days that don't have to be made up. In a year with more than five days taken off for inclement weather, we would be extending the number of attendance/instructional days for students and staff. As a result, we will not plan to use e-learning days the first semester and will base the use of e-learning days versus a traditional emergency day in the second semester on the number of emergency days already used, the predicted forecast for weather, and how far we are into the second semester. When the announcement for the school closing is made, we will indicate at that time whether it is an e-learning day or a traditional emergency day.
