Most of these selections come from Illinois' own list, The Abraham Lincoln Award list, or from Jesse White's state list, Reading for a Lifetime. A few have been added from other states' lists including Missouri's, Indiana's, Georgia's, Kansas', and Florida's. These have been chosen as the best books to entice teens to read. In order to engage their interest and to provide a spur to critical thinking, the book selections include those that involve sensitive issues. The content of some of the titles may be more mature than younger students may have previously encountered. Please recognize that this is a voluntary reading program. Not every book selected will suit every student. In a democratic society, a variety of ideas must find voice. As readers, teens have the choice to read the more mature titles or to close the book.**
