BUS RIDING RULES

- 1. Follow the directions of and be respectful to the bus driver and aide.
- 2. Students will remain in their seats and keep themselves and other objects inside the bus at all times.
- 3. Keep voices quiet. Do not yell. Do not distract the driver.
- 4. Stay completely silent at all railroad crossings.
- 5. Keep all harmful objects and materials such as glass, alcohol, drugs and weapons off the bus. Also no animals of any kind or balloons.
- 6. Do not swear, use rude gestures, spit or tease/bully on the bus.
- 7. No pushing, shoving or fighting of any kind on the bus.
- 8. Do no litter, write on, or damage the bus in any way.
- 9. Do not throw or shoot objects of any kind on the bus.
- 10. Do not throw anything out of the window.
- 11. Do not take books, homework, or any such items out of your book bag on the bus.
- 12. No cellular devices of any kind on the bus.
- 13. No tobacco products of any kind on the bus. Including, vape pipes and E-cigarettes.
- 14. No eating/drinking on the bus. This includes soda, candy, gum, snacks, etc. In hot weather bottled water only with a cap may be allowed at the discretion of the driver.

CONSEQUENCES

- 1. A verbal warning from the driver.
- 2. A light consequence from the driver and documented.
- 3. A letter and or phone call sent home from the transportation director. The principal will be notified as well.
- 4. Possible loss of bus riding privileges. <u>NOTE</u>: Severe violations such as fighting, damage to the bus, threatening someone or open defiance to the bus driver or aide may result in a loss of bus riding privileges with no warning.
