ENGLISH IV DUAL CREDIT

GENERAL INFORMATION

- English IV and English IV Honors (British Literature) are dual credit classes.
- **ELIGIBLE** English IV students are enrolled in IECC English 1111 for the entire year.
- English IV Honors students are enrolled in IECC English 1111 for first semester and English 1121 second semester.
- All classes are worth 3 semester hours.

ELIGIBILITY

- To be ELIGIBLE for dual credit in these classes, students must have earned EITHER a minimum score on the COMPASS TEST or ACT. (<u>THIS SCORE IS</u> <u>DETERMINED BY IECC, NOT FHS.</u>)
- To **EARN** dual credit, students must earn a minimum of an 80% C.
- English IV students must earn a COMBINED AVERAGE OF 80% for both semesters.
- English IV Honors students must earn dual credit first semester to receive dual credit second semester.

STUDENTS THAT DO NOT MEET THESE REQUIREMENTS WILL BE AUTOMATICALLY DROPPED FROM THE IECC CLASS. RADING

GRADING

- The FHS grading scale will be used for grade cards, class rank, and no pass/no play.
- A college grading scale will **ONLY** be used to send grades to IECC.
